

Rules of Play:

- 1. Everyone is welcome to participate.
- 2. All boats 16' and under are eligible, all Captains must have their Boaters Card
- 3. All Captain's should refrain from alcohol and are to abide by all 'rules of the road'.
- 4. The course can be attacked from any direction so as all boats do not arrive at each check point at the same time.
- 5. There is no reward for the fastest or slowest time as to help prevent accidents.
- 6. All envelopes with enclosed cards must remain sealed until judging—any open envelopes will be voided.
- 7. All participants must register at the Pavilion between 11:30am and 1:00pm on the day of the event.
- 8. All boats will line up facing west in front of the Yacht Club docks by 1:15pm where all starting ceremonies will take place off the bow a boat in that vicinity.
- 9. Check points will be located as follows (changes will be announced at registration):
 - 1) Seven Winds gas dock—do not block way for paying customers
 - 2) Christines gas dock—do not block way for paying customers
 - 3) Open water, weather permitting, details to follow.
 - 4) Armstrong East, behind island on north side of the Conservation Area.
 - 5) Walden North
 - 6) Lazy Acres boat ramp.
 - 7) Mystery Stop.
- 10. Each boat will receive one (1) set of seven cards, if all check points are visited.
- 11. Extra hands can be purchased for \$6.00 or \$5.00 PFYC members.
- 12. As each boat arrives back to the Conservation area and docked the Captain or one of their 'rum runners' should check in so the committee knows they are finished and their card envelopes will be signed by both parties and retained by the committee for judging.
- 13. All decisions by the committee will be final and binding.
